Proceeds help the blind and visually impaired throughout the Czech Republic to live better and independent lives by providing special aid equipment, guide dogs and personal assistants, just to name a few.





The **Run for Světluška** charity event started at 9:00 in the evening, routing runners and walkers through city streets. Nearly 70 associates represented Beckman Coulter Prague and Bratislava, helping to raise US\$6,900 in matching gift donations from the **Beckman Coulter Foundation**. This, Beckman Coulter Prague's first official event under the Foundation's OUS Volunteer Events Program, was a great success.
