Charity Run in Limerick

Bon Secours Hospital Limerick at Barringtons is a part of Ireland's largest independent healthcare organization and delivers advanced medical care to the community. Each year, the hospital offers support to charities and projects that benefit disadvantaged groups such as the homeless and disabled.



At the Bon Secours Hospital [Great Limerick Run](#) on Sunday, May 6, a team of 43 associates from Beckman Coulter Ireland participated as runners and walkers in the annual event.
